| Description: | <p>The Saluki Student Investment Fund (SSIF) seeks to provide students with experience in the area of investment management. Through the SSIF, students have discretion over the management of a real dollar portfolio. The SSIF began in April 2000 and is currently recruiting 5 to 10 students from Southern Illinois University to be portfolio managers.</p> <p>The Fund is actively managed. Portfolio managers are expected to follow a sector of the economy, e.g., energy, and select stocks for the fund's portfolio.</p> <p>The managers are expected to participate in meetings and also assist in the preparation of quarterly reports. <i>Failure to attend meetings may result in dismissal from the Fund.</i></p> <p>The Fund also seeks a web administrator, who may or may not also be a portfolio manager. The web administrator will design and maintain the SSIF website. No previous experience is required, although some experienced is preferred.</p> |
| Requirements: | <p>The only requirement is that the applicant be a registered undergraduate student at Southern Illinois University. Factors considered in the application process include: GPA, grades in FIN 330 & 331 (if taken), and anything that a person could possibly contribute.</p> <p>**December 2009 graduates are welcome to apply.</p> |
| Selection Process: | The faculty advisor will evaluate applications. Applicants will be notified of their status by September 2, 2008. |
